**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR AUTHORITY TO SELL  
FURNITURE, FIXTURES, AND EQUIPMENT THROUGH PUBLIC  
AUCTIONS AND FOR APPROVAL OF NOTICING PROCEDURES**

THIS CASE came on for hearing on June 27, 2019, at 2:00 p.m. (the “**Hearing**”) upon the  
*Motion for Authority to Sell Furniture, Fixtures, and Equipment Through Public Auctions and for*

*Approval of Noticing Procedures* (the “**Motion**”) filed by the Assignee, Soneet Kapila, to sell furniture, fixtures, and equipment of the Assignors through one or more public auctions. The Court, having considered the statements of counsel, and the lack of opposition by any party in attendance at the Hearing, and being fully advised of the record, finds that the Motion is well taken and should be granted. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED:

1. The Motion is granted.<sup>2</sup>
2. The Assignee is authorized to sell the physical assets, primarily consisting of furniture, fixtures, and equipment of the Assignors (the “**Assets**”) at one or more public auctions, to be conducted by Centurion Service Group LLC (“**Centurion**”).
3. The Assignee is authorized to pay Centurion all fees and expenses under the terms and conditions agreed-upon in the Inventory/Appraisal & Auction Agreement between Centurion and the Assignee.
4. The Assets shall be sold free and clear of any liens, claims and encumbrances, with any such liens to attach to the proceeds of the sale.
5. The Assignee is authorized and directed to remit the net proceeds of the sale to lienholders as their interests may appear.
6. The notice procedure set forth in the Motion is approved. The Assignee shall, not later than seven days prior to the proposed auction date, file a Notice of Auction containing (a) the date and time the auction will be held; (b) the location of the auction; and (c) instructions on how to obtain more information about the auction, including information on how to participate in the auction. The Court finds that the Notice of Auction procedure, together with the notice provided

by the Motion, provides sufficient notice to interested parties of the proposed sale(s) of assets. To the extent necessary, any applicable notice requirements are modified pursuant to Section 727.111(6) of the Florida Statutes, such that the above-described notice procedures are deemed to provide adequate and sufficient notice of the sale(s) of assets.

7. The Assignee is authorized to cancel any scheduled auction, notwithstanding the filing of a Notice of Auction, without the need for further Court approval.

8. The grant of authority to conduct the auctions described in the Motion is provided without prejudice to the Assignee's ability or right to sell any of the Assets through private sale or in-place sales. Any such private sale shall be subject to notice and Court approval as required by Chapter 727 of the Florida Statutes.

9. Counsel for the Assignee shall serve this Order in compliance with the *Order Granting Assignee's Motion to Limit Notice*.
